Evaluation Criteria for TECHNICAL PAPERS, CASE STUDIES & RESEARCH PAPERS:

Preliminary Evaluation:

- All entries will be evaluated at various stages by a team of professionals.
- The technical team of the host will scrutinize the entries and assign marks based on defined criteria.
- The host reserves the right to select articles that meet the requisite standard and align with the seminar theme.

Final Evaluation:

- The author(s) will be allowed to present their technical papers, case studies, personal experiences, and research papers during the event. The presentations will be scored based on the following criteria:
 - 25% for the relevance of the topic to the theme
 - 25% for the quality of the content presented
 - 25% for the practical applicability of the topic
 - 25% for the presentation style of the presenter
- Final evaluation will not be conducted if the presenters fee is found to be pending.
- The author(s) shall register themselves as paid presenters and must present their papers, preferably in person.

General Rules and Guidelines:

A. Paper Submission Guidelines:



1. All Technical Papers, Case Studies, Experiences, and Research Papers must include the Title, Author's Name(s), Designation, Organization, and Contact Details.
2. The manuscript must be in English, neatly typed in 'Arial' font with font size 11, and should not exceed 3000 words.
3. The total length of the paper, including photographs, graphs, sketches, etc., must not exceed six A4 size pages.
4. All entries must be sent via E-mail to sopepseminar@gmail.com in MS-Word format only. Any other file format will not be accepted.
5. The work submitted must be the original work of the author(s) based on their own experiences and must not be copied, in full or in part, from any other publication.
6. Authors must ensure that the content is free from plagiarism. The host will not be responsible for any plagiarism found, and plagiarism will lead to disqualification.
7. All entries should be forwarded to the host well before the mentioned last date of submission. Entries received after the closing date or not meeting the specified conditions will be rejected.
8. All entries must not contain any header or footer of the participating organization.
9. All Technical Papers, Case Studies, Experiences Shared, and Research Papers must align with the event theme.

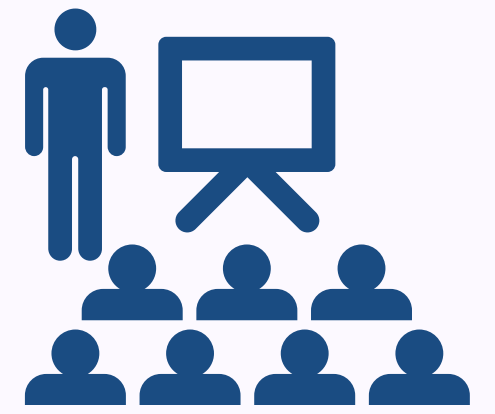
B. Guidelines for Participants:

1. All case studies and research papers shall be proved or made operative in the last two years. Any scheme implemented of earlier times shall not be considered for competitive awards. However, may be considered for appreciation by a panel of judges if found fit in any category.
2. An additional special category of papers are invited where corporate have taken special steps or actions in light of the current war and current energy crisis.
3. Authors may send the complete technical Paper/ Case Studies along with the filled in Delegate Registration Form.



C. Presentation Guidelines:

1. Each presentation will be approximately twenty minutes in duration. The actual time for the presentation will be announced at the time of the event if required.
2. Presenters may use PowerPoint, Video Clips, or any other form of computer-aided presentation.
3. All presenters must submit their presentations in PowerPoint format, Video Clips, or any other displays to the host by email at least 2 days prior to the commencement of the event.



D. Copyright & Registration Guidelines:

1. All entries are the property of the host and the copyright of the submitted items will rest with the host. The host will have the right to make use of them in a manner deemed fit.
2. The author(s) of the shortlisted entries and/or their representatives must register as paid presenters and must be present at the event.

All entries will be evaluated by the Technical Seminar Committee of the host.

1. The decision of the Committee with respect to awards, etc., will be final and binding on all concerned. .
